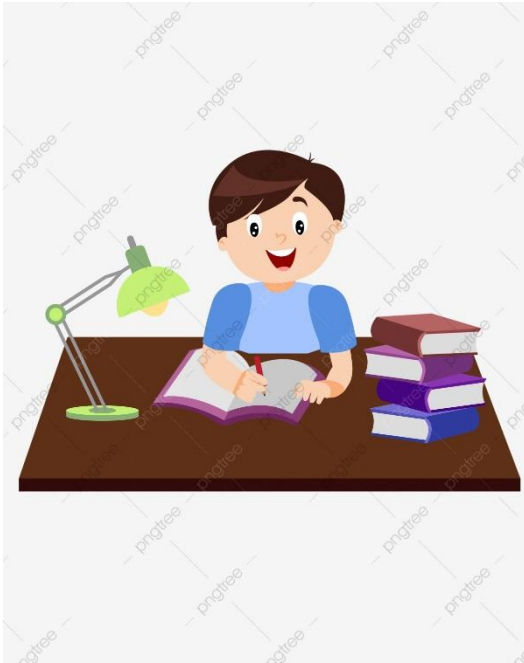

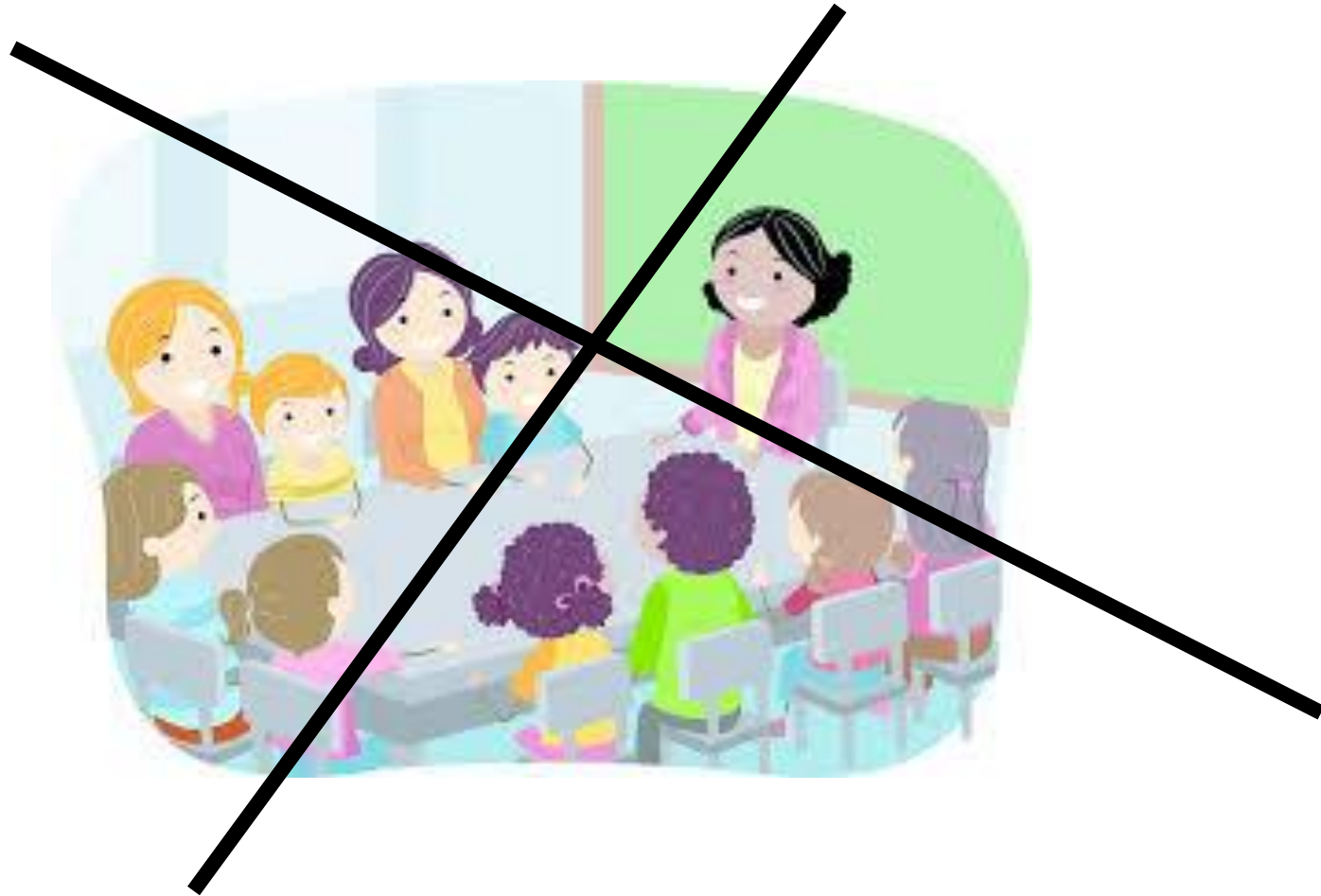

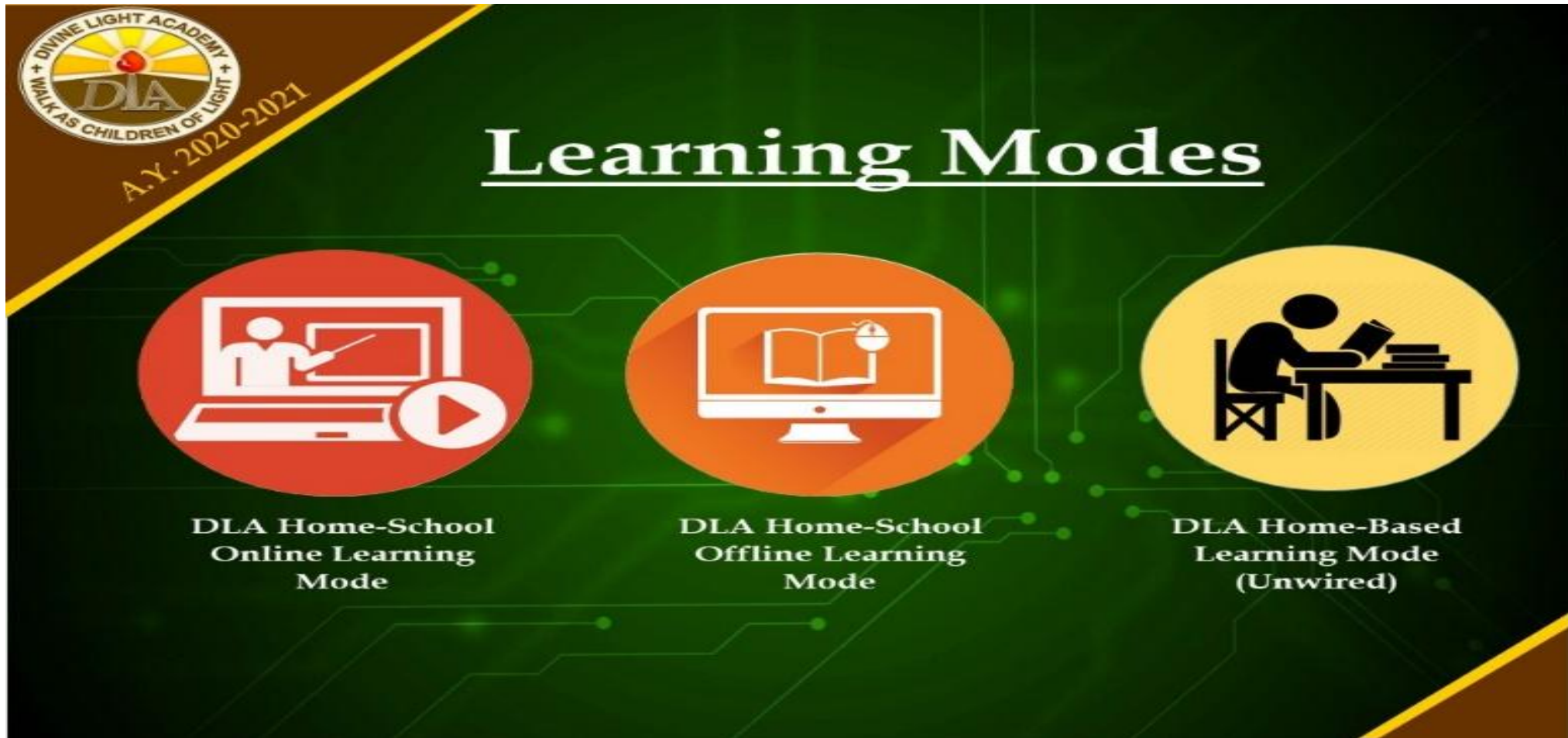

Synergy Group

Online face-to-face lesson with teacher for at least 15-45 min. at the start of the period, followed by students working on their own using e-resources, physical textbooks.



Integrity Group

NO real-time teacher's presence, but all learning activities are identical with online learning; learning packages sent through student's /parent's email or Genyo Account.



Autonomous Group

all competencies are identical with the online/offline learning; weekly printed modules with textbooks and worksheets to be picked up or sent to parents' email or iphone.

Summative Assessments

- Authentic Real Life Situations and Issues
- Evidence-based
- based on the Most Essential Learning Competencies
- focused on the 3R's (Reasoning, Reliance, Responsibility)
- interdisciplinary

Parents' Role in Assessments

- Parents are urged **not** to do their children's exercises, quizzes, and performance tasks, and summative tests.
- In this way, the teachers will be able to identify the difficulties of the learners and provide necessary interventions (remedial teaching).
- The learners' difficulties or deficiencies can be addressed during parent-teacher conferences.
- Honesty and integrity should be practiced at all times.
